The Wed. night rights are intermediate/advanced and intimidates beginner/casual riders and also leaves a bad impression for those who have shown up.
 2. We need to reach out and welcome people into the club who currently ride and are already doing activities like trail building.
- Jim Malta continued the discussion of combining the MNWW and NMBA camp/race weekend(s) in May or June 2007 (discussed at the last meeting). It was agreed that the weekend should be marketed/advertised/planned to try to appeal to everyone from beginners to advanced riders, downplaying the race aspect of the weekend. There is still some question as to how possible this might be, so there will be more discussions in the future.
