

## NMBA Meeting Notes

### **TRAILS**

- Croyle: Neil talked to Mark Potter at DCNR. The budget impasse is slowing the processes for the Forest management of Musser Gap. Likely DCNR won't get to work on Croyle until Fall 2016. Neil also talked to Applied Trail Research (Jeremy) about how much it would cost the club to pay for the completion of the Croyle plan;
  - As planned would be  $\approx$  \$24.2K
  - Jeremy indicated with some modifications we could reduce to  $\approx$  \$13K
  - Working with DCNR our cost would be  $\approx$  \$6 500 (already approved in Oct '14)
- Kepler Trails: Donovan meeting with Mark and Jake (DCNR) re: new trails near Ag Progress Days. More to come.
- Greenlee: Aaron Hofelt started scouting, but more will be needed after the snow melts.

### **PA Interscholastic Biking League**

- PA races are getting organized and are looking at developing something in the Centre region. Good course = 4-6 miles, lots of parking (races usually bring about 200 participants), an infield.
